Dear Parent/Legal Guardian:

You are receiving this letter due to requirements of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), formerly known as No Child Left Behind. The purpose of ESEA is to improve educational opportunities for all children attending a Title I school. This federally funded program provides assistance to schools serving students who are at risk for academic failure. This legislation supports the school district's efforts to provide a strong standards-based educational program for students along with accountability for student achievement. Some low-performing schools will also receive a federal label of either Focus or Priority. Either of these labels allow parents to apply for Public School Choice Transportation. Additionally, Arizona law has its own accountability system that designates schools with a letter grade from A through F. This will help parents better understand how our schools are performing academically.

- 1. Our school's state label is: C-Alt
- 2. Our school's <u>federal</u> label is: <u>Focus</u>. This is due to <u>Low Achievement</u>.

Since <u>Arizona Call-A-Teen Center of Excellence</u> operates a Title I program and has a federal <u>Focus</u> status, you have the option of Public School Choice with free transportation to another school in our district not identified as either Focus or Priority. However, Arizona Call-A-Teen Youth Resources is a one-school district. There are no public school choices available within the district.

School Improvement Plan

We have been working with the district and the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) to revise the Continuous Improvement Plan for Arizona Call-A-Teen Center of Excellence. In order to address the indicators that led to our Focus or Priority status, the district and ADE are assisting this school in:

- Providing support in developing/revising an Continuous Improvement Plan
- Providing goals and strategies to increase the low achievement rate
